The international students in our district do not receive funding in the form of scholarships, bursaries, or financial aid from the school or any related 3rd party but the fees charged to attend School District #60 are less than \$26,000.

Does this mean all of the international students in our school district and other public school districts across the province whose fees are below \$26,000 are ineligible to participate in BC School Sports?
